By completing this form and allowing the USACE Family Readiness program to contact your Family during your deployment, you are assuring that you and your Family can effectively manage deployment, strengthen Family relationships, and help reduce deployment stress.

Please complete the Family Readiness Information Form 6037-E. You must complete a minimum of **Section I Communication** and **Section II Employee Information**. You will be able to make changes or update your form as your situation changes. You can specify the level of contact the Family Readiness Program has with your Family. You can change the level of support at anytime. Thank you for your service to USACE.
